This position is responsible for providing Engineering service delivery focused around capital projects, including the planning of scope considerations through consultation with Council and the public; budget consideration; public engagement; project administration; assisting in the creation of “Requests for Proposals” and “Request for Quotations” and undertaking technical review and providing construction supervision. Emphasis is on the delivery of Capital Projects with strong environmental awareness.

The incumbent may be required to assume lead responsibility for specific projects.
