Reporting to the Manager of Parks; with functional leadership from the Parks Supervisor and Parks Lead Hand, the Labourer I Parks is responsible for performing a variety of parks related tasks; horticulture training or previous experience is required. With the exception of routine duties; a supervisor will issue detailed instructions, monitor work progress and do inspections upon completion.
