NATURE AND SCOPE OF WORK

Reporting to the Director of Engineering, the Manager of Engineering contributes to the overall leadership of the City of Colwood as a member of the municipal leadership team and is responsible for managing the Engineering Division in the delivery of efficient and effective planning, protection, and maintenance of City of Colwood's natural and built environment, while ensuring the City's engineering standards and bylaws are current and adhered to in order to achieve the City's goals. The incumbent's responsibilities are Engineering with an emphasis on Capital projects and Development projects, and not limited to the Engineering department.

The Manager of Engineering is accountable for safe work practices by exercising due diligence and understanding the role of WorkSafe BC and the statutory and regulatory requirements. The Manager will promote safety through their active participation in all aspects of OSH programs including regular inspections, safety meetings, investigations, and safety events.

Travel may be required to conduct project review and/or to attend courses as approved by the Director of Engineering.
