NATURE AND SCOPE OF WORK

This position reports to the Manager of Roads and Utilities, with functional supervision from a Supervisor and a Lead Hand. The Labourer I performs manual work entailing considerable physical effort in the performance of a variety of construction and maintenance tasks; previous training and experience is required. Apart from routine duties, a supervisor will issue detailed instructions, monitor work progress, and do inspections upon completion.
