- **Heritage Vision Statement Recommendation and 2020 End of Year Update:** Iain Bourhill, Director of Community Planning, presented the Heritage Vision Statement Recommendation and 2020 End of Year Update to Council.

Council recognized the vision statement which focuses on protecting its surviving heritage resources and implementing innovative approaches to conserve and celebrate Colwood's intangible heritage and historically important landscapes.

Council voted to direct the Heritage Commission and staff to explore the potential partnerships with the Royal BC Museum to develop West Shore focused community heritage infrastructure programming as part of the future collections and Research Building at Royal Bay.
