- **Public Participation:**
 - Two residents expressed concern regarding the rezoning application for 3460 and 3461 Veterans Memorial Parkway
- **Delegations:** Laura-Lee Johnson (manager) and Marianne Whitaker (Owner) of Alphabet Zoo daycare addressed Council regarding the rezoning of their property at 3322 Fulton Road. A staff report regarding the rezoning is tentatively scheduled for Committee of the Whole on March 1, 2021. Read the [correspondence](#).
- **Correspondence Requiring Council Direction:** Council received a request to raise the Greek flag and illuminate the exterior of City Hall in support of the 200th anniversary of Green independence. Council discussed the [City of Colwood Flag Protocol Policy](#).
- **Historical Interpretive Signage for Royal Bay:** Council approved a recommendation from the Heritage Commission that options for local historical interpretive signs be developed at Royal Bay and Royal Beach. Read the original [correspondence](#).

- **UBCM Community Emergency Preparedness Fund:** Council supported a request from the Fire Chief to apply to the Union of BC Municipalities (UBCM) for the Community Emergency Preparedness Fund (CEPF) up to \$25,000 and to provide overall grant management for Emergency Support Services. - **Draft Parks and Recreation Master Plan:** Council supported staff commencing the draft Parks and Recreation Master Plan external review and referral process and upon completion, returning to Council with a summary of responses as well as the final draft for consideration and endorsement. - **2021 Grant in Aid:** Council moved to award grant in aid funding of \$40,100 as listed in the report, that off-cycle grant in aid funding be awarded to Royal Bay Secondary, and that only those applications received on an annual basis for purposes of awarding grant in aid funding.
