 - Last week premier David Eby announced a \$1 Billion growing communities fund grant to local government intended to upgrade infrastructure, build, or improve community amenities. Available to all municipalities, calculated on a population basis, this grant will be distributed by the end of March this 2023.

- IACDI Request for Minute Taking Support (Video Time Stamp 59:00)
 Following a Notice of Motion from the January 23, 2023 meeting, Council directed staff to return with options to provide minute taking support to the Intermunicipal Advisory Committee on Disability Issues Meeting (IACDI).
- WSPR 2023 2027 Financial Plan Approved: (Video Time Stamp 1:05:05) Grant Brown, Chief Administration Officer of West Shore Parks and Recreation presented Council with the West Shore Parks and Recreation 2023 – 2027 Financial Plan. There is a 5% increase for proposed 2023 requisition with Colwood's share totalling \$76,983 of the total 2023 requisition. Council approved the Financial Plan as presented.

Council moved to refer to this process to the Finance Committee, once established, to evaluate current methodology and provide options on alternatives prior to 2024 grant In aid process.

• **Rezoning Application RZ-22-002 for 595 Bezanton Way Denied:** (Video Time Stamp 1:44:05) Council received a presentation regarding the rezoning application for 595 Bezanton Way. The applicant has requested to amend the permitted uses, height, and front yard setback in Area 4 of the CD13 Zone to allow construction of a 6-storey building comprised of 142 units. After discussion, Council voted to deny the application.

 Rezoning Application RZ-21-006 for 3211 Jacklin Road Approved: (Video Time Stamp 2:52:10) Council was presented with a Rezoning Application for 3211 Jacklin Road. The applicant is requesting an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to rezone from the Residential 1 (R1) Zone to a new Comprehensive Development 37 (CD37) zone. The new zone would allow construction of a mixed-use apartment building consisting of ground floor commercial space and 52 condo units. Council approved the staff recommendation and directed staff to amend the Land Use Bylaw to allow this rezoning. To view the full recommendation, refer to the <u>report</u>.
