- **Checkout Bag Bylaw:** Council received [correspondence](#) regarding the Checkout Bag Regulation Bylaw No. 1757 from Carol Brown, Citizen Environment Network in Colwood. Council directed staff to return with a briefing of [Bylaw No. 1757](#) which was read for a second time on February 25, 2019.
- **Delegations:**

- **Summary Report, Colwood Active Transportation Network Plan Projects Foundation:** Following a recommendation and discussion during the March 1, 2021 Committee of the Whole Meeting, Council received the summary report with the addition of following amendment “AND THAT subject to budget approval:”. Staff were instructed to:
 - proceed to tender and construct Metchosin Road and Painter Road projects as planned in 2021
 - immediately initiate project scoping and return to Council in time to complete construction in 2022 for the following projects:
 - Kelly Road Sidewalk (Sooke to Metchosin)

 - Owen Road Sidewalk
 - Hagel Road Sidewalk
 - Adye Road/Metchosin Road Bikeway
- begin project scoping and return to Council in time to complete construction in 2023 for the following projects:
 - Lagoon Road Sidewalk
 - Fulton Road Sidewalk
 - Metchosin Road Sangster School Sidewalk
 - Metchosin Road South Bike Lane
 - Metchosin Road North Bike Lane
- pave a temporary sidewalk from the Wishart/Latoria intersection to the pathway to Outrigger Place (approx. 20m)
