Mayor's Message:

- Mayor Kobayashi thanked Seacliff and Reliance Properties for hosting the first, and well attended, Royal Beach Pub Pop Up event on June 10th and 11th.
- Arts & Culture Colwood is hosting the Flatdeck Musical Theatre, a summer production of Tuck Everlasting, Saturday, June 17, 2023 at 3:00 pm at Meadow Park Green.
- National Indigenous People's Day is June 21, 2023 with Royal Roads University hosting festivities from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm and Colwood is a sponsoring partner.

• Public Participation:

- One member spoke on behalf of Arts & Culture Colwood Society regarding agenda item 9.2 - Creating a Colwood Volunteer Program.
- A member spoke on behalf of Friends of Havenwood Park encouraging volunteer programs expanding in Colwood parks
- A member spoke regarding traffic calming on Lagoon Road and a motion that was passed last Council meeting.
- Members spoke regarding the Land Use Bylaw Amendment (2054-2076 Sooke Road)
 - concern for the lack of affordable housing
 - concern for increased traffic and loss of privacy and sunlight
- One member spoke against agenda item 7.1 requesting closure of Ocean Boulevard during avian nesting season.

• Delegation - Ukrainian Sister City Agreement:

Bob Beckett provided a presentation on the Ukrainian Sister City Agreement. Councillor Ward was presented with a flag of Ukraine for involvement with procurement of funding of an orthopedic drill set.

Staff were directed to put together a staff report to formalize a Sister City with one of the Ukrainian Cities.

Council received correspondence regarding Ocean Boulevard closure during avian nesting and referred this item to the Waterfront Stewardship Committee to look at the environmental and traffic impacts.

Notice of Motion - Intermunicipal Advisory Committee on Disability Issues:

Councillor Day brought forward a Notice of Motion that will be discussed at the June 26, 2023, Council Meeting.

Councillor Day introduced the following motion: That the Intermunicipal Advisory Committee on Disability Issues become a standing Committee or Commission to meet the new accessibility legislation requirements with annual funding to be a line item in the budget.

• Tenant Displacement Assistance:

Following a Notice of Motion from the May 23, 2023, Council Meeting, Council directed staff to provide background and analysis regarding the potential for tenant displacement in Colwood and propose a Tenant Assistance Policy intended to guide Council's decision making in cases where rezoning applications involve displacement of residential tenants.

• Creating a Colwood Volunteer Program:

Council received a presentation on Creating a Colwood Volunteer Program, fostering connectedness and building community.
