Ken has over 800 sound track credits as composer include Cannes and Sundance winner "In the Company of Men". International Emmy winner "The Magician's House" and Peabody winner "The Threads of Hope." He was also nominated for a Video Premiere Award for Best Composer for [The Crimson Code](#). His other composing credits include Warner's "Police Academy" and Disney's "So Weird."

Sherry is a dynamic drummer who developed her groove from many years of performing in different musical genres.
