

CITY OF COLWOOD

BYLAW NO. 508

A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE PIONEER CEMETERY AND ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST HERITAGE CHURCH AS PROTECTED HERITAGE PROPERTIES.

The Municipal Council of the City of Colwood, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 967 of the *Municipal Act*, Lot 4, Section 71, Esquimalt District, Plan 5451, known as Pioneer Cemetery, is hereby designated as a protected heritage property.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 967 of the *Municipal Act*, that part of Lot 1, Sections 71 and 70, Esquimalt District, Plan 20764, shown outlined in a heavy black line on the sketch attached hereto as Schedule "A", and known as St. John the Baptist Church, and the building known thereon as St. John the Baptist Church is hereby designated as a protected heritage property.
3. In respect of each property, interments in the normal course of cemetery operation do not require a heritage alteration permit.
4. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Heritage Designation Bylaw (Pioneer Cemetery and St. John the Baptist Heritage Church), 1999."

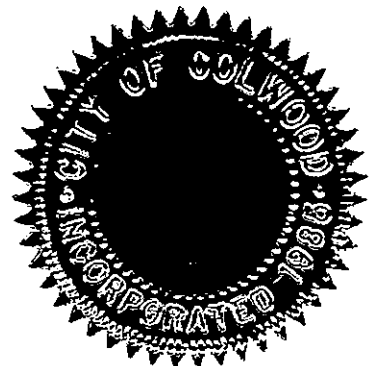
