- (1) You must meet all of the requirements in this section in order to register as a Resident Elector.
- (2) Print applicant's surname and given names in full in block letters here.
- (3) Print applicant's residential address, including street number and name, city/town and postal code.
- (4) Print mailing address if different from the residential address.
- (5) This information is required pursuant to the *Local Government Act*.
- (6) This information is to identify persons who have had a name change since the last election and who were on the list of electors.
- (7) Applicant must sign here.
- (8) A person who was present when applicant signed his/her name on line (8) must sign here.
- (9) Witness' address here. Not required if the witness is an election official.
- (10) If person is registering at the time of voting, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove both residency and identity are required. If the person does not have documentation showing residency, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) are still required and the person must make a solemn declaration as to their place of residence.
