RANDOM ACT OF KINDNESS DAY

- WHEREAS The Victoria Foundation, a charity serving the Capital Region for over 80 years, builds community vitality;
- WHEREAS Random Act of Kindness Day® has brought Canadian communities together since 2008 by engaging citizens in small acts of kindness and generosity;
- WHEREAS November 4, 2016 has been earmarked by the Victoria Foundation and community foundations across the country as a day to recognize kindness and humanity in our communities;
- WHEREAS Random Act of Kindness Day is a celebration of simple kindness that encourages people to tap into their own human spirit and share kindness with one another, thereby nourishing and strengthening our communities;
