IDEAS LIST WITH SUMMARY DESCRIPTIONS

WATERFRONT

Note: The waterfront ideas below are informed by City and private development processes concurrent to this plan: the Colwood Waterfront Improvement Project, and Royal Beach Developments.

Peninsula Waterfront Park Upgrades

- Continuous multi-use pathway
- Soft-shore (GreenShores) restoration
- Tree planting, ecosystem and riparian enhancement
- Design adaptation for sea level rise
- Celebration of indigenous and cultural heritage
- Improved parking, including EV charging, and bike parking
- Washroom improvements / additional location at bridge end
- Amenities such as: public art, seating areas, picnic areas, viewpoints, accessible beach access points, potable water access, outdoor performance space

2 Royal Beach Community Waterfront Park

- New community park, development-related
- Parking, bike parking, EV charging station
- Washrooms / changerooms
- Accessible boardwalk & trail connections
- Shade trees and natural areas
- Amenities such as: community event space, picnic / gathering area, covered shelter, lawn, play amenities, tennis / pickleball courts, beach volleyball courts, designated dog beach area

Paddling Launch Area (non-motorized boats)

- For non-motorized boats including kayaks, paddle-boards, windsurf boards, etc.
- Nearby parking & walk-up access to launch
- Accessible for wheel / cart access
- Potable water source
- · Consideration for breakwater to aid launching
- · Close proximity to other waterfront amenities

MAJOR TRAIL CONNECTIONS

Note: The major trail connection ideas outlined here are informed by City and Private Development processes concurrent with this plan: the Colwood Waterfront Improvement Project, Royal Beach Developments, Latoria Area Developments, and the Colwood Active Transportation Network Plan.

8 Community Waterfront Route Network

- Continuous public trail access between the head of lagoon (by bridge) to the City boundary south of Royal Beach
- · Develop new trail sections and link to upgraded existing trail sections
- Target accessibility for wheels
- Provide rest points, interest points, and connections to adjacent upland amenities and economic development opportunities

9 ROYAL – Beach to Mountain Route Network

- Link existing trail segments with upgrades to new trail segments to provide a continuous trail route from the beach at Perimeter Park up to a lookout at the top of Havenwood Park
- Develop lookout areas by Perimeter Pl. and Gratton Rd.
- Include seating/rest areas, trail markers, and interpretive signage throughout

10 LATORIA – Mountain to Beach Route Network

• Link the high point in Havenwood Park down to the beach and waterfront at the southern City limit by linking existing trail segments with upgrades in Latoria Walk Park and Latoria Creek Park with new trail segments through Pondside Park and undeveloped parks parcels

COMMUNITY PARK IMPROVEMENTS

Note: The details for improvements at each community park will be confirmed through subsequent park master plans for each. The outlines below provide guidance for scope and prioritization of these plans.

4 Colwood Creek Park Improvements

- Permanent washrooms / change rooms
- Covered shelter (by play)
- Additional benches and picnic tables
- Dog off-leash area on Cecil Blog side including potable water source
- Parking improvements, bicycle parking
- Improve park drainage for public use lawn areas
- Amenity considerations: bike pump track, tennis / pickleball courts, disc golf course, youth parkour / adventure play, public art, outdoor performance space

5 Ocean View Park Improvements

- Washrooms
- Additional benches and picnic tables
- Amenity considerations: covered picnic shelter, potable water access, youth parkour / adventure play, forest nature play area

6 Lookout Lake Park Improvements

- Washroom improvements (currently seasonal)
- Trail and stair improvements
- Beach / swim area improvements
- Additional benches and picnic seating
- Amenity considerations: covered shelter, potable water source, kids
 nature play amenities

Havenwood Park Improvements

- Highway parking & entrance upgrades
- Stair repair
- · Additional benches, lookouts, and rest areas
- Amenity considerations: washrooms, forest nature play area, interpretive signage, outdoor class seating

- Include seating/rest areas, trail markers, and interpretive signage throughout
