SITE PLAN

The overall site is tied together through a network of trees and linked plaza spaces.

Parking areas emphasize pedestrian movement and tree canopy. Edges at Jerome Avenue are defined by rain gardens, while street trees line Sooke Road. Storefronts are highly visible with paved surfaces fronting the parking.

The following pages illustrate how the internal plazas establish a material palette and design aesthetic that creates a unified landscape throughout the development.
